Writing instructions and life-cycles. Recounting the story of 'The Little Red Hen'. Forming lowercase and capital letters correctly. Writing sentences using capital letters and full stops.

As athletes we will be:

Combining movements in Gymnastics. Confidently use apparatus indoors and outdoors. Developing body-strength, balance, co-ordination and agility

As mathematicians we will be:

Exploring the composition of numbers to 10. Learning to subitise (estimate). Measuring ourselves and beans over a period of time. Weighing vegetables and seeds. Looking at patterns in Nature. Sharing seeds using simple number operations. Making symmetrical paintings and drawings.

As explorers we will be:
